How to Enter Outside CEU Credits in Your AAPL Member Profile

Members may submit continuing education credits for qualifying courses completed outside of AAPL. All courses must meet AAPL's definitions of Landwork and follow AAPL's CEU-calculation guidelines.

Qualifying Coursework Requirement

To be eligible for CEU credit, the course content must clearly relate to one or more of the following Landwork Definitions:

- A. Negotiating for the acquisition or divestiture of Mineral rights or rights associated with Other Energy Sources.
- B. Negotiating business agreements for the exploration or development of Minerals or Other Energy Sources.
- C. Determining ownership of Minerals or associated rights through research of public or private records.
- D. Reviewing title, curing title defects, conducting title due diligence, and reducing title risk related to ownership, acquisition, or divestiture of Mineral or Other Energy Source interests (excluding administrative, division order and lease analyst functions).
- E. Managing rights and/or obligations arising from ownership of Minerals or rights associated with Other Energy Sources.
- F. Unitizing or pooling interests in Minerals or rights associated with Other Energy Sources. *Minerals include oil, gas, related hydrocarbons, coal, lignite, uranium, and substances classified as base, industrial, precious or strategic minerals.*

Other Energy Sources include wind, geothermal, and solar energy.

Courses that do not align with these definitions may not be eligible for CEU credit.
