CRC THUMS Island was built back in 1965 to access the oil reserves of the Wilmington Field and today produces more than 20,000 barrels of oil per day from an integrated network of about 2,000 production and water injection wells. Earn 3.5 CEUs while learning more about this iconic island.

Signal Hill Petroleum is a privately owned California-based energy company specializing in responsible and sustainable exploration and production as operations co-exist with residential and commercial neighbors. Earn 4 CEUs on this field trip.
