

CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL LANDMAN APPLICATION

You are responsible for reading the current Certification Policies (pg. 34-44) found in the **AAPL Policy Manual**, as amended. A brief summary of the Certification Policies is listed below; however, in the event of a conflict between this summary and the Policies, the Policies shall prevail.

SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS. DEFINITIONS AND RULES

- I. In order to be qualified to become a CPL, you must:
 - 1) Have at least 10 total "Credit Years" comprised of Education and full-time experience as a Land Professional;
 - 2) Be primarily engaged, on a full-time basis, in the performance of "Landwork" as outlined below for at least the immediate past two years;
 - 3) Score at least a grade of 70 on each part of the AAPL administered CPL exam;
 - 4) Have earned a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited university or college; and
 - 5) Be an ACTIVE (not Associate) member of AAPL for at least 1 year.
- II. "Land Professional" shall mean a person who derives a significant portion of their income as a result of performing Landwork.
- III. "Landwork" shall mean the actual performance or supervision of any one or more of the following functions as outlined in the **AAPL Bylaws**:
 - A. Negotiating for the acquisition or divestiture of minerals or real property associated with or connected to energy sources.
 - B. Negotiating business agreements that provide for the exploration for and/or development of minerals or real property associated with or connected to energy sources.
 - C. Determining ownership in minerals or real property associated with or connected to energy sources through the research of public and private records.
 - D. Reviewing the status of title, curing title defects, providing title due diligence and otherwise reducing title risk associated with ownership in minerals or energy sources or the acquisition and divestiture of minerals or real property associated with or connected to energy sources, but shall not include division order or lease analyst functions.
 - E. Managing rights and/or obligations derived from ownership of interests in minerals or real property associated with or connected to energy sources.
 - F. Unitizing or pooling of interests in minerals or real property associated with or connected to energy sources.

For each year during which you primarily performed, on a full-time basis, Landwork you will be awarded one (1) "Credit Year".

- IV. The following Education credits (up to a maximum of 5 "Credit Years") are available for meeting certain educational requirements:
 - a. 3 "Credit Years" are awarded for a bachelor's degree earned from a **regionally accredited university** or college;
 - b. 1 additional "Credit Years" are awarded If the bachelor's degree above is with a concentration or major in Petroleum Land, Energy or Natural Resource Management from an **AAPL accredited university** or college;
 - c. 1 additional "Credit Year" will be awarded if you have earned a law degree from an ABA-approved law school;
 - d. 1 additional "Credit Year" will be awarded for an advanced degree earned in business or certain other select programs approved by AAPL.

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ARE YOU QUALIFIED TO BECOME A CPL?

1. "Landwork" Experience

"Landwork" as defined in Article II of the AAPL Bylaws, which can be found online or in the Membership Directory, is the performance of Landwork as follows:
