AAPL-ACCREDITED UNIVERSITY PROGRAMS

AAPL accredits undergraduate and graduate-level programs offered by universities with an emphasis on curriculum complementary to land professionals. University programs desiring accreditation must complete an application through AAPL and successfully meet all requirements to receive accreditation. Once fully accredited, programs are re-evaluated every five years by the AAPL Accreditation Committee with a required site visit and curriculum review. The Landman Scholarship Trust requires attendance by all accredited program directors (or their designee) at an annual meeting where each program provides updates.

AAPL will work with the accredited programs to encourage the infusion of new talent into the profession by, among other benefits, offering free AAPL student membership to students enrolled in the accredited programs, eligibility to apply for scholarships through the AAPL Landman Scholarship Trust and eligibility to apply for AAPL Outstanding Graduate (undergraduate programs only). Graduates of the accredited programs also benefit from having reduced credit-year requirements for certain AAPL certifications.

In recent years, AAPL has awarded approximately \$250,000 annually in scholarships. These scholarships help future land professionals with tuition and are based on financial need and interviews.
